News

Weather

<u>US</u>: arrival of winter weather in the northern United States. Snowstorm in recent days in South Dakota, lost 60,000 head of cattle and concerns about the harvest progress and quality of crops.

<u>Black Sea</u>: no rain for the next 7 days, winter sowing and harvesting of spring crops should be activated. <u>Brazil / Argentina</u>: rains are expected in the coming days to reduce dry conditions and accelerate seeding soybean.


<u>China</u> Chinese private operator bought 420KT of US corn. Deliveries are scheduled in the second half of the marketing year.

<u>France</u>: wheat exports reach 2.6 Mt in the first two months of the marketing year. This is a 17% more than 12/13 MY.

Russia 's wheat crop is now 87% harvested, 17% in corn and 20 % in sunflower.

Oilseeds

 $\underline{\text{US}}$: Returns of soybean yield show very satisfactory results as harvest progress. As a result, we are revising our 2013 average yield 43bu/acre for domestic production of 89MT (USDA = 85.7 MT).
