WASDE:, Nov 8, Dec 10

GRAINS: stable to bear corn/ stable to bull wheat

Improvement of winter planting conditions in Black Sea region/ risk in Argentina

Break technical point

India risk: could cut floor price by \$40/T for wheat exports to boost sales (6MT of exports)

OILSEEDS: stable to bull OSR and sunseed

OSR: less vegoil bear impact (premium of sunoil and rapeoil over soyoil) but still large supply of seeds Sunseed: slow French harvest and losses in Black Sea are supportive

News

Cereals

Taiwan: Tender for 60KT corn for January 14 deliveries.

Russia: 80% of winter cereals sown and 40% of corn acreage harvested.

<u>Argentina</u>: The estimated production of 8.8 MT wheat announced by the government last week, is a preliminary estimate before the release of official figures in the coming days.

Oilseeds

Taiwan: Tender for 120KT soy for January 14 deliveries.

Russia: 44% of the sunflower area harvested.

US: Sales of soy 235KT for an unknown destination

<u>Malaysia's</u> palm oil exports up 8% over the first two decades of October compared to the same period in September.

<u>Argentina</u> improved weather conditions in the northern area of soybean production. While conditions remain very dry, between 10 and 50mm are expected over the next two weeks.
